■ Season Preview

Penguins Hope Pitching Can Carry Them in 2010

Midway through the summer of 2008, Youngstown State head coach Rich Pasquale had an optimistic feeling about the upcoming 2009 campaign. He brought in a large influx of touted position players for his second year on campus to join with the solid core he had remaining. Before the start of fall ball, four pitchers – two talented JUCO transfers, a possible starter and a primary bullpen option – did not meet academic requirements, and another lefty departed the program because of personal reasons. That left the Penguins with a very thin pitching staff, and a 6.62 ERA was a contributing factor to a 16-35 record.

In a complete turnaround, pitching should actually be a strong suit in 2010 as seven new hurlers join all-league starters Aaron Swenson (2008) and Phil Klein (2009). Add in six returning position starters, all of whom batted higher than .275, and the Penguins and their third-year skipper have high hopes of returning to the top tier of the Horizon League in 2010.

Klein was arguably the most-improved player in the Horizon League last season and became a major bright spot for the Penguins' future. The 6-foot-7 right-hander went 5-1 with a 4.19 ERA during the regular season before a rough outing in the Horizon League Tournament upped his ERA to 4.62. He was dominant against conference foes during the regular season, turning in a 4-0 record to go along with his 3.83 ERA and 61 strikeouts in 56.1 innings. With his frame and 9.5 strikeout rate per nine innings, Klein has developed into a professional prospect entering his junior year.

That said, Klein may not even be YSU's No. 1 when the 2010 season commences because of senior Aaron Swenson. Swenson was the Horizon League Pitcher of the Year as a sophomore before a lingering back injury resulted in a disappointing 2009 campaign. He still threw 90 innings and struck out a career-high 70 batters, but his injured back contributed to leaving pitches up, and his batting average against rose from .258 to .325. In 2008, Swenson was 6-3 with five complete-game wins and a 3.55 ERA. This past summer, he went 5-2 with a 2.20 ERA and 63 strikeouts in 65.1 innings in the Valley League. He ranked second in the league in strikeouts and third in ERA, and he was chosen as the league's starting pitcher in the Mid-Atlantic Summer Classic. He should be 100 percent healthy on opening day.

Junior left-hander Cody Dearth returns after going 2-5 with a 4.96 ERA in 13 appearances, 10 of which were starts. He'll get competition from seniors Alex Oles and Corey Vukovic and freshmen Blake Aquadro and Bill Turosky for the final spot in the weekend rotation. Oles signed with Pittsburgh out of high school prior to 2006, but Tommy John surgery and transfer issues have limited him to one collegiate game. Vukovic is a breaking ball pitcher who has started 16 times in his career.

The bullpen will be anchored by arguably YSU's most valuable player, Eric Marzec. The senior can hit the mid 90s with his fastball and the mid-to-upper 80s with his slider, and he will start in the middle of the batting order as a starting outfielder. He missed a month with a wrist injury to his glove hand last year, but he still managed to drive in 27 runs and hit six home runs. On the mound, Marzec had a batting average against of .242, and he struck out 20 batters compared to six walks. He earned Second-Team All-Horizon League honors as a utility player for the second time.

Also in the bullpen, senior Anthony Munoz gained valuable experience in his first year on the mound last season by throwing in 27 games, and senior Trent Wood pitched in 21. The relieving corps will also get a lift from the group who loses the battle for the final weekend spot in the rotation.

Returning First-Team All-Horizon League shortstop Jacke Healey returns to compliment Marzec in the middle of the order. Healey, a JUCO transfer, led YSU in homers (eight) runs (37), RBIs (36) and doubles (17) in his first year of Division I baseball. He also had just 10 errors in 197 chances at shortstop. The senior may play some innings at third base this season, which would move starting second baseman C.J. Morris to short. Morris batted .281 a year ago.

Incoming freshmen Neil Schroth and Zac McFarland will battle for the starting third base job. Jeremy Banks emerged late in the year to show flashes of a star in the making at first base. He batted .302 with four home runs and 30 RBIs as a freshman, and he hit .439 with 18 RBIs over the final 11 contests. Junior Greg Dissinger, who has power from the right side, will also see time at first or at designated hitter.

Senior Anthony Porter headlines a deep and talented group at catcher. Porter has hit at least .316 in both of his seasons at YSU, and he upped his home run total to four last season. Porter also has one of the league's best arms behind the plate. Sophomore Jonathan Crist is a stalwart defender who hit .278 last season, and senior Casey Holland batted .243 in 43 games.

With Marzec the likely starter in right, sophomore Derek Carr will enter the spring as the probable starter in center. Carr batted .250 in 39 games last season, and his team-best .469 average with runners in scoring position helped him knock in 16 runs. Junior Joe Iacobucci batted .287 last season and .369 as a freshman, and he will start in left or at designated hitter. Junior walk-on Armani Johnson had a strong enough fall to enter into the competition to start in left, and senior Eric Hymel will compete for a spot after playing in 42 games last year.
